

With convenient public transport links and various local car parks (walking times: 2 minutes from Shudehill bus interchange and Metrolink, 5 minutes from Victoria rail station and 10 minutes from Piccadilly rail station), CFCCA has been the perfect venue for networking events, seminars, training courses, exhibitions, performances and product launches.

Directions

CFCCA is located 5 minutes away from both NCP and Euro car parks.

Walking from Manchester

Victoria train station

Turn left out of the main entrance and walk south-east on Victoria Station Approach, towards the National Football Museum.

With the museum on your right, turn left on to Wither Grove and continue up hill past the Printworks.

CFCCA is located on Thomas Street which is a right-hand turn directly opposite Shudehill bus interchange and Metrolink stop.

Walking from Manchester

Piccadilly train station

Exit via Station Approach and walk downhill towards Piccadilly Gardens. Turn right onto Ducie Street, then left onto Dale Street. Continue on Dale Street for approx 450m before turning right on to Oldham Street.

Take the next left onto Thomas Street and continue - CFCCA is on the right hand side, opposite Trof bar and Bar 21.
